General certification conditions for products certified against the VERS Standard (PROS 99/07)

Meaning of certification

Certification indicates that the software product has been evaluated as compliant with one, two or all of the specifications of the Victorian Electronic Records Strategy (VERS) Standard, *PROS 99/07 Standard for the Management of Electronic Records version 2.0*, as defined in the compliance statement above. Certification does not guarantee that a product will in all circumstances be configured in compliance with these requirements, and it does not imply any liability relating to use of the product in any implementation.

Use of certification

Certification is given to a specific product set and product version, as supplied by the named supplier who mounted the test environment. Certification does not extend to:

- approval of later, or earlier, versions of that product
- approval of product sets which contain one or more components of the approved product set; for example approval does not extend to an untested product pairing where only one component is approved
- approval of the same product set from a different supplier, except where the approved product set is supplied to a third party as part of a wider systems integration project.

Certification does not imply any form of product endorsement; it does not imply a preference for any one product over another within this scheme.

Suppliers may refer to this certification (within the meaning described above) in product literature to indicate conformance with the VERS Standard. **Under no circumstances** may suppliers make any use of the PROV or Victorian Government logos in product advertising in any circumstances. The supplier may not use the outcome of certification testing in a manner that may suggest or connote an endorsement of the product.

Product listing

PROV will list certified products on the VERS website, and include a very brief description and a direct link to the appropriate supplier by e-mail or website address. Products will be added to the list as certification is confirmed.

Withdrawal of certification

Withdrawal of this certification will occur under the following conditions:

- If a significant problem with the product emerges which would have caused the product to fail the compliance testing process, and this problem can be demonstrated to have been known to the supplier at the time of testing.
- Where unanticipated problems emerge with a certified product, PROV will aim to work with the supplier or product developer to resolve problems without withdrawal of certification, and may then wish to conduct further evaluation to assure continued conformance.
- If the outstanding issues identified in the statement of certification are not addressed and remedied, or if PROV is not notified in writing about these repairs.
